student housing business explodes

This summer is looking to be very busy for the student housing arm of hardison/downey construction. With developer American Campus Communities out of Austin, h/dc broke ground on two (2) projects at NAU's campus in Flagstaff, and will break ground on its second housing project at the University of New Mexico in July.

The two NAU projects combine for a total of 1,126 beds in 419 units. The \$60.6 million project will consist of two (2) unique and separate developments: a modern residence hall called McConnell (550 beds) and a student townhome community called Hilltop (576 beds). NAU Hilltop introduces a private bedroom / private bathroom apartment design on campus with superior amenities to off-campus competitors. The modern suite-style McConnell residence hall will feature a community center, which includes a fitness center, theater, social lounge, business center and a plaza with 4,360 s.f. of retail space.

The University of New Mexico Johnson Core development is a 1,027-bed modern residence hall, and is the first traditional residence hall constructed on-campus in over 45 years. With a price tag of \$39.4 million, the project features bathrooms within each of the 272 units and offers a level of privacy not available in existing on-campus residence halls. It will consist of four (4) separate buildings each containing laundry and kitchen facilities, as well as study rooms and social lounges. A community center will offer additional amenities such as a business lounge, recreational area and office space.
